The role of the Cardiac Rehabilitation program is to offer support to clients in Fraser East who have experienced a cardiac event and engage with them to facilitate healthier choices and lifestyle change. This is a critical step to ensure that clients are able to receive the education and exercise they need to recover and prevent future heart health problems. The benefit of cardiac rehab and the impact on risk reduction is well established and supported in research. Due to the high demand for this program, ARH expanded and established an onsite exercise program in April 2016. Low risk patients still exercise at the Abbotsford Recreation Center and our moderate risk patients exercise in the Cardiac Clinic on

Yale 2. Since opening we have continually been expanding the onsite program to accommodate the demand. Our dedicated and passionate Cardiac Rehab team, with the support of the Fraser Valley Health Care Foundation, organized a fundraising event **"Walk for Cardiac Health"** on May 11th 2018. They met their goal target of **\$8,000.00** to buy a new Step Machine for the program. A great big THANK YOU to this team, the Foundation and to all of you who supported this event as it truly does promote health in our community.



On April 26th 2018, the Fraser Valley Health Care Foundation held the official opening of a new Simulation Lab at Abbotsford Regional Hospital. The lab was a grassroots effort which began with local physicians, nurses and respiratory therapists. These individuals identified a need for simulation in this region and formed a committee. The Abbotsford Simulation Group (ASG) spent countless volunteer hours building a business plan and creating an effective space for education. The ASG worked closely with the Fraser Valley Health Care Foundation and Fraser Health to make the program a reality. Fraser Valley Health Care Foundation raised approximately \$450,000 for the new space which allowed the group to purchase state of the art simulation mannequins and the technology and accessories necessary for a functional lab. City Councillors, Fraser Health Executive, Physicians and Hospital staff attended the ribbon cutting and were privy to a tour of the new lab called, "Abbotsford Regional Centre for Health Education and Simulation" or "ARCHES" for short. The Foundation unveiled a recognition board commemorating the fundraising and volunteer efforts of those involved. Thank you to the Fraser Valley Regional Hospital District for helping make this project move forward.



We are extremely grateful for Crystal Gala's support of a new mammography machine with a stereotactic unit at Abbotsford Regional Hospital. They recently presented us with a cheque for \$362,500 - halfway to their goal of \$725,000 for the new machine.
